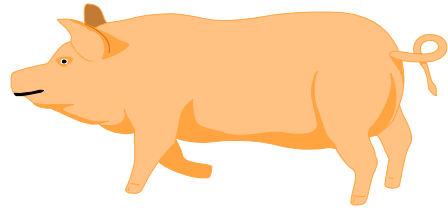
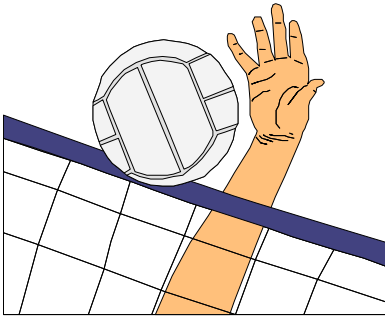

So much to do, and so little time Stay cool!

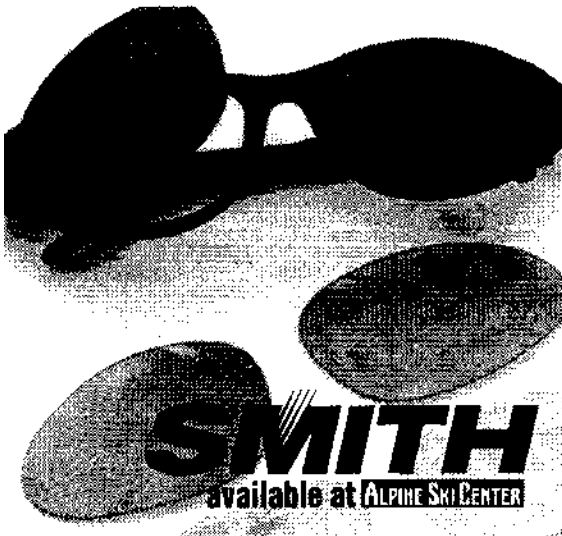


MEETING DAY CHANGE

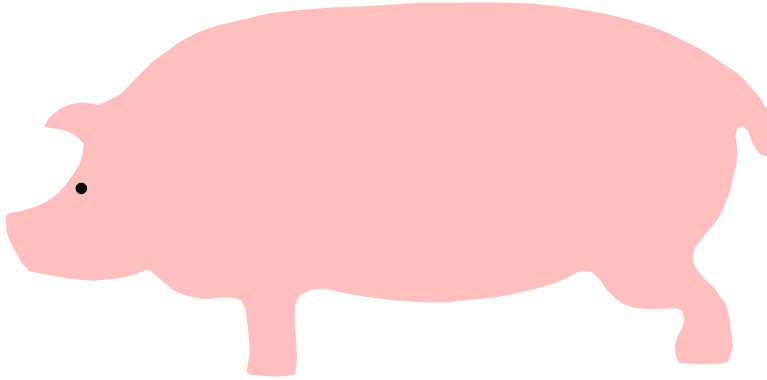

RAFTING/KAYAK TRIP

WE HAVE A WILD AND WONDERFUL WHITEWATER WEEKEND PLANNED FOR JULY 25 TH AND 26TH. SATURDAY WOULD BE RAFTING ON THE OCOEE RIVER NEAR CLEVELAND, TN., WHICH IS THE SITE WHERE THE 1996 OLYMPIC WHITEWATER EVENTS WERE HELD. SUNDAY WOULD BE A BEGINNERS KAYAK COURSE AT NANTAHALA, COMPLETE WITH INSTRUCTORS, STARTING ON STILL WATER (A LAKE) AND MOVING ONTO EASY WHITEWATER. YOU WOULD HAVE A CHOICE OF STANDARD KAYAK OR "TOP SEAT " KAYAK (FOR THOSE WHO MIGHT HAVE A FEAR OF ROLLOVER).

YOU MAY SIGN UP FOR EITHER OR BOTH, BUT SINCE IT'S A 4.5 HOUR DRIVE TO CLEVELAND, TN. EACH WAY, OR 3 HOURS DRIVE TO NANTAHALA EACH WAY, IT IS BEST IS TO SIGN UP FOR BOTH AND PLAN TO SPEND SATURDAY NIGHT IN MURPHY, NC. THAT WAY YOU WOULD TRAVEL 4.5 HRS. TO THE OCOEE, AFTER RAFTING DRIVE LESS THAN AN HOUR TO MURPHY, SPEND THE NIGHT, HAVE A ONE HOUR DRIVE TO NANTAHALA ON SUNDAY, KAYAK, AND THEN 3 HRS. HOME. THIS WILL ALSO MAKE CARPOOLING MORE FEASIBLE. NANTAHALA OUTDOOR CENTERS (NOC) WILL BE OUR OUTFITTERS FOR BOTH TRIPS. SIGNED RELEASES ARE REQUIRED.
