### **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**



### **Pig Roast Alert**



Are you up for some golf, hiking, kicking back and relaxing in the cool fall weather of the Tennessee mountains?


Most of our members are familiar with Roan Mountain State Park from our annual winter trip. We decided to offer a weekend trip when you can leave your sleds and skis at home.
