



## 2001 ROAN MOUNTAIN FALL WEEKEND SEPTEMBER 28-30

Our second Fall Trip includes two nights' lodging and a get-together on Saturday night (details to follow). Optional activities include golf and hiking.

Seven cabins are reserved in the "new section". These units are one-bedroom (double bed) with a large loft divided by a partition (a double bed on each side), so there is room for six in each cabin. Two bathrooms are downstairs.

The cost for the weekend is \$40 per person (based on two persons per bed).

The cost for an entire cabin is \$240.

Golf will be at nearby Mountain Glen Golf Club. The cost for green fees, cart, and prizes is \$45 per golfer.

### 2002 WESTERN TRIP TO VAIL RESORT JANUARY 26-FEBRUARY 2 VAIL, CO

Our western ski trip in 2002 will be toVail. Vail offers acres of skiing from groomed beginner and intermediate runs to the fresh powder of the back bowls.

Adjacent to Vail is Beaver Creek, which is a cruiser's paradise. Beaver Creek, Keystone, and Breckenridge are available on a Vail lift ticket. Vail buses run between Vail and Beaver Creek but not to the other resorts.

Lodging is at Vail International in 2 BR/2 bath condominiums. These accommodations are in the Lions Head area of Vail with a short walk to the lifts. The Vail International is on a level area with the hot tub equally accessible to the condominiums.

Our flight is on American Airlines leaving Greenville/Spartanburg at 7:00 AM and arriving at Vail Eagle Airport at 10:42 AM. We will leave Vail Eagle at 1:25 PM and arrive back in Greenville at 9:05 PM. These times could vary slightly as we get closer to the trip. Bus transportation is included in the price of the trip and for ground-only packages.

We have already locked in reasonable group lift tickets for this trip. There will be the usual party (parties?) and an optional private NASTAR race with prizes awarded.

The price per person including air is \$1,007. The land-only package is \$594.

Many of you have sign-up sheets and I can provide additional sign-ups.
