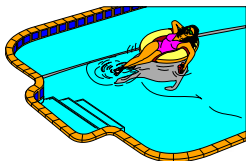


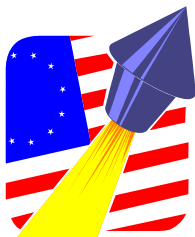

Use this afternoon to relax with your friends. Bring your chair, a towel, your food & drink (in other words, everything but the pool)! I'll have a grill and of course, the pool.

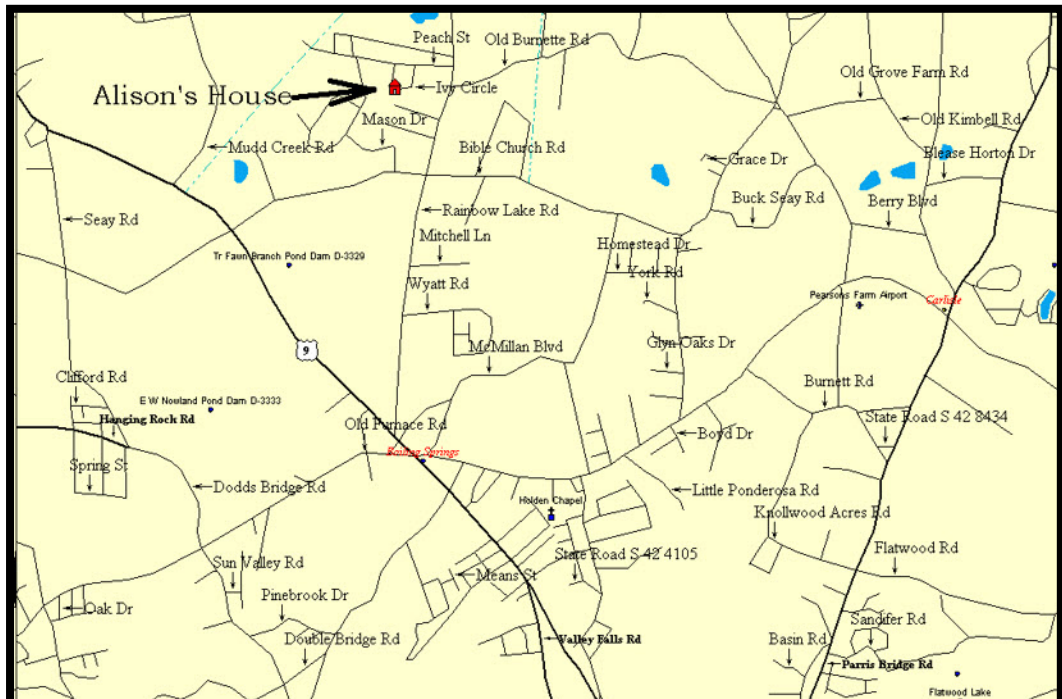
