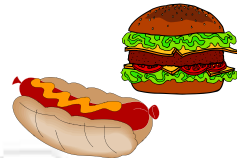

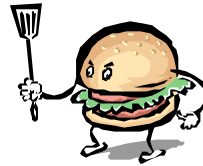
MUSINGS & RUMINATIONS

HICKORY KNOB STATE PARK

GOLF AND LAKE OUTING

We have scheduled our annual golf and lake outing to Hickory Knob State Park for May 23 – 25, 2003, which is Memorial Day weekend. Hickory Knob State Park is located outside of McCormick, SC on beautiful Lake Strom Thurmond (formerly known as Clark Hill) with a 6,560 yard championship golf course. Plan to arrive on Friday May 23rd. We have a captain's choice golf tournament starting at 10 am on Saturday and at 9 am on Sunday. Prizes for the winning foursomes will be awarded.

The two night's accommodations (required) will be in the park motel facilities, and we have rooms reserved closest to the lake and across the street from the restaurant. Each room comes nicely furnished with two double beds, cable TV, etc. A swimming pool, tennis courts, and even a practice green are located in the motel complex. All packages include breakfast at the restaurant both days, **except the room only rate**. Golf packages include green fees and cart for both days.

Weekend packages and rates as follows:

Golfers (based on double occupancy) - \$110.00 per person (\$55.00 per golfer per day or \$220.00 total for golfing couple))

1 golfer (not sharing a room) – \$140.00 (\$70.00 per day for one golfer / single occupancy)

1 golfer and 1 non-golfer per room - \$170.00 for both (\$85.00 per two people per day, includes room and breakfast for both. Includes golf for one.)

Note: above prices include breakfast and SC sales tax.

Motel room only / non-golfers (breakfast not included) - \$104.00 for the two nights including sc tax.

Space is limited and reservations are on a first deposit basis, so sign-up early to get in on this great value and fun weekend, call Bryan Bobo at 433-8640(h) or 433-8640 (w).

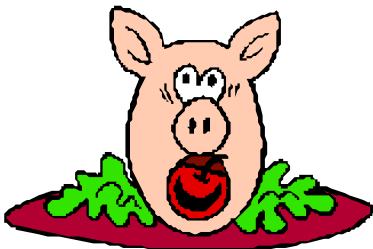


Special Events and Pig Roast News
