Hickory Knob State Park
April 14-15, 2006

We have reserved five cabins for Friday and Saturday nights at Beautiful Hickory Knob State Park for April 14-15 of next year.

The cabins are near the lake and are one BR cabins. I understand the cabins are fully furnished and have two double beds in the BR and a hide-bed. They will sleep from two to six people depending on how cozy you want to be.

The cost is \$185.23 for the entire cabin for the two nights. Golf is available at their beautiful course. The lodging does not include the golf as they no longer have a golf package. It does guarantee tee times at a preferred rate of \$26 per round. This is for green fees and cart. Breakfast is no longer included. You will get complimentary coffee and tea at their restaurant. They still have the buffet breakfast available for a reasonable price.

A deposit of one night will hold your reservation for one cabin. The deposit is \$92.62 with the balance of \$92.61 due shortly before the trip. First come, first served as there are no guarantees we can obtain additional lodging.
