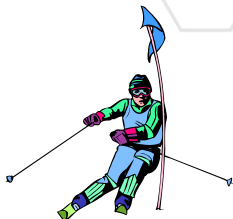

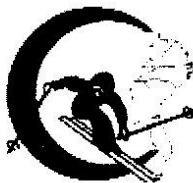
Non skier for a 2 night stay deducts \$86, for a three night stay deduct \$129.00

Junior rates for 2 and 3 nights (children under 12-may sleep on couch/floor if ok with everyone in the unit): \$58/87, respectively. If juniors are sleeping in a bed they will be charged the full rate.

CANCELLATION POLICY: You may cancel up October 28th, 2005 and receive a full refund. Any rooms not guaranteed with a deposit are subject to cancellation on October 28th, 2005. Any rooms cancelled after October 28th, 2005 will be subject to a 100% penalty if the resort cannot resell the units. If the race is cancelled due to not enough snow, you will receive refunds based on refunds provided from the resort. The Race Committee will try to make this decision no later than noon on Tuesday preceding the Saturday race.

NOTE In hopes to increase participation from clubs we have continued to budget into the cost of the trip a ½ reimbursement for a (1) trip leader per club per 25 respective adult club members paid. This is based on full occupancy in a 2BR for 2 nights and includes lift ticket. Reimbursements will be issued after the trip to-no exceptions. Reimbursements will be issued to the trip leader with the checks made out to the respective club to be distributed per club policy.

Rooms wishing a late check out are subject to availability. Late check out is the responsibility **of the** individuals in their respective rooms. The cost is \$40 plus tax.

April 14-15, 2006

We have reserved five cabins for Friday and Saturday nights at Beautiful Hickory Knob State Park for April 14-15 of next year.

The cabins are near the lake and are one BR cabins. I understand the cabins are fully furnished and have two double beds in the BR and a hide-bed. They will sleep from two to six people depending on how cozy you want to be.

The cost is \$185.23 for the entire cabin for the two nights. Golf is available at their beautiful course. The lodging does not include the golf as they no longer have a golf package.
