25th ANNIVERSARY - STEAMBOAT RACE & SKI CAMP - 2008

SIGN-UP: All applicants must be a member of a Crescent Ski Council affiliated club at time of the trip to participate. Applicant's membership will be verified by CSC. Everyone must sign-up directly with our travel agent, Sports America Tours (SAT) in Santa Rosa, CA. SAT will require a filled-out & signed application form to be confirmed onto the trip. Checks must be made payable to SAT.

SIGN-UP PERIOD: Sign-up period begins April 25, 2008 and ends November 17, 2008, or When 400 is reached, whichever comes first SAT will not accept any form of application for sign-up prior to, nor after this period.

TRIP DATES: December 6-13, 2008

<u>PACKAGE COST(VARIES):</u> \$840 is the "base" rate in a 3B/3B unit, which is limited in quantity (usually about 120 spaces). Other rates/options are available (see below).

SILENT AUCTION AT THE PIG


