

Music On Main Thanks



Steamboat dates: Dec 5-12, 2015. This is a great opportunity to get the season off to a good start: 5 days of lessons, convenient lodging, meals, Parties, and the Friday NASTAR race, banquet, and awards. Everyone is welcome; never-evers to experts. The first 72 to sign up get the special price of \$1029, then it goes to \$1065, still a good deal. Registration is from May 20th to Nov 6th.
