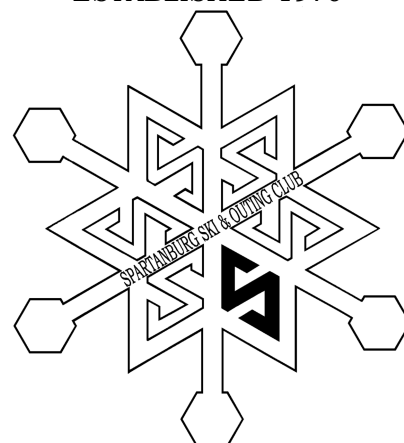

Mike Rogers Activities Coordinator

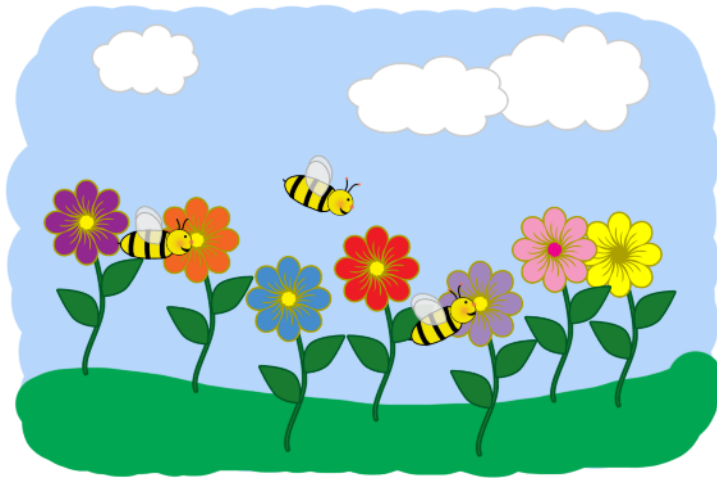

Treasurer News

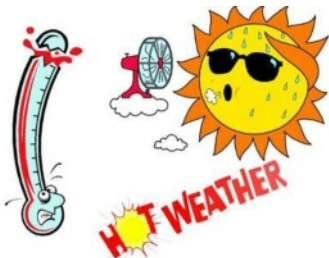


The balance in the treasury as of March 14 was \$4,429.59. The balance on April 14 is \$3,414.49.

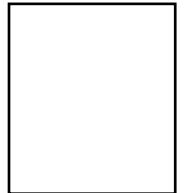


