
PROSE FROM THE PREZ:

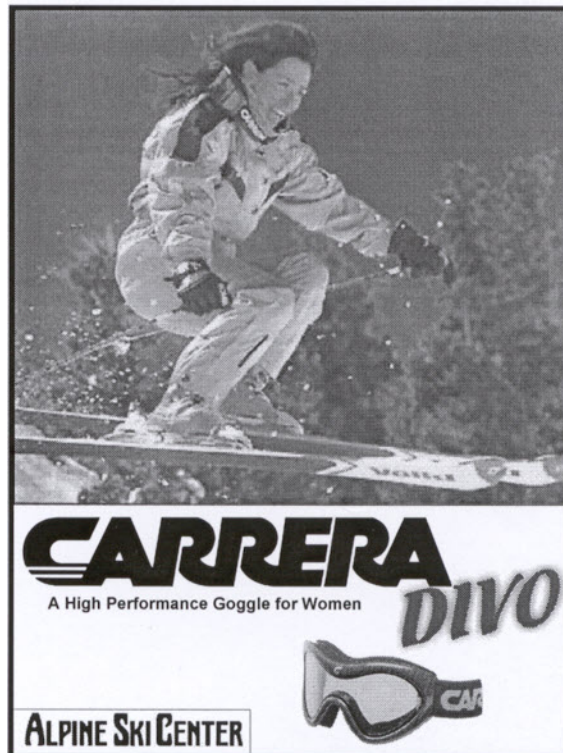

There are three price structures. All of these prices include lodging for Friday and Saturday nights. The rates are based on double occupancy per room:

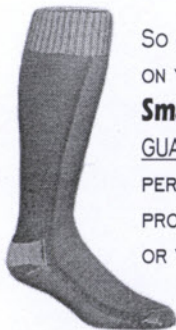
