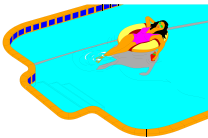


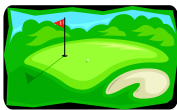

MUSINGS & RUMINATIONS

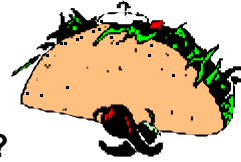
As summer marches on one is tempted to pursue one of those fabulous skiing trips to South America or New Zealand. If only money and time were as available as we wish....

Spartanburg Ski and Outing Club Trail Ride



We are planning a trail ride through the woodlands and vast open meadows of mile-high Cataloochee Ranch in Maggie Valley, NC, on Saturday, September 27th. Our ride will start out at 2:00 p.m., and last about 2 to 2 1/2 hours, and will cost \$45.00 per person. Plan to arrive about 1:00 p.m. with a picnic lunch which we'll eat on their lovely grounds. They also have a full-service restaurant.

What to wear: riders should wear long pants and sturdy footwear with a heel. Rain gear is provided, but you may bring your own if you prefer. A sweater or jacket should be taken along as it might be cool up in the mountains. They have and recommend riding helmets. All riders are grouped according to ability. How to get there: take I-40 west, take exit 27, and follow signs to Maggie Valley.
