


Note: A \$10.00 fee will be assessed for EACH missed deadline.

Non skier for a 2 night stay deducts \$70.00, for a three night stay deduct party only: \$15.00 \$105.00

Junior rates for 2 and 3 nights (children under 12-may sleep on couch/floor if ok with everyone in the unit): \$48.00/72.00, respectively. If they actually want a bed subtract \$22,00/33,00 from the package price, respectively.

CANCELLATION POLICY: You may cancel up December 1", 2003 and receive a full refund. Any rooms not guaranteed with a deposit are subject to cancellation on December 1", 2003. Any rooms cancelled after December 1st, 2003 will be subject to a 100% penalty if the resort cannot resell the units. If the race is cancelled due to not enough snow, you will receive a full refund. The Race Committee will make this decision no later than noon on Tuesday preceding the Saturday race.

NOTE in hopes to increase participation from clubs we have continued to budget into the cost of the trip a ½ reimbursement for a (1) trip leader per club per 25 respective club members paid. This is based on double occupancy for 2 nights and includes lift ticket. Reimbarsements will be issued after the trip-no exceptions. Reimbursements will be issued to the trip leader with the checks made out to the respective club to be distributed per club policy.


