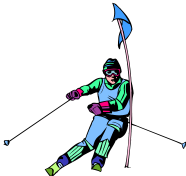

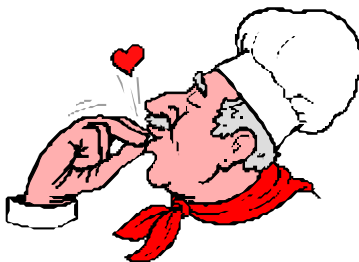

CANCELLATION POLICY: You may cancel up December 1st, 2003 and receive a full refund. Any rooms not guaranteed with a deposit are subject to cancellation on December 1st, 2003. Any rooms cancelled after December 1st, 2003 will be subject to a 100% penalty if the resort cannot resell the units. If the race is cancelled due to not enough snow, you will receive a full refund. The Race Committee will make this decision no later than noon on Tuesday preceding the Saturday race.

This is based on double occupancy for 2 nights and includes lift ticket. Reimbursements will be issued after the trip-no exceptions. Reimbursements will be issued to the trip leader with the checks made out to the respective club to be distributed per club policy.
