

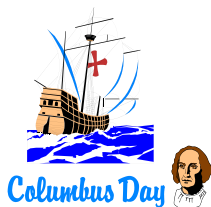

NOTE In hopes to increase participation from clubs we have continued to budget into the cost of the trip a ½ reimbursement for a (1) trip leader per club per 25 respective adult club members paid. This is based on full occupancy in a 2BR for 2 nights and includes lift ticket. Reimbursements will be issued after the trip, no exceptions. Reimbursements will be issued to the trip leader with the checks made out to the respective club to be distributed per club policy.

Rooms wishing a late check out are subject to availability. Late check out is the responsibility of the individuals in their respective rooms. The cost is \$40 plus tax.
