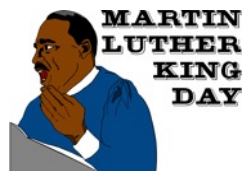

Non skiers, staying at Silvercreek, can deduct the cost of lift tickets from their trip costs. No deductions will be given for people not wishing to attend the party.

Cancellation Policy: You may cancel up to January 15th, 2012 and receive a full refund. Any rooms not guaranteed with a deposit are subject to cancellation on January 15th, 2012. Any rooms cancelled after January 15th, 2012 will be subject to an 100% penalty, if the resort cannot resell the units. If the race is cancelled due to weather issues, you will receive refunds based on refunds provided from the resort. The race committee will try to make this decision no later than noon on the Tuesday preceding the Saturday race. The trips committee will make every effort to get as much money refunded as possible if the trip is cancelled.

Note: We have continued to budget a ½ reimbursement for a trip leader per club per 25 pillows paid. This is based on full occupancy in a 2BR unit for 2 nights and includes the lift ticket. The value of the reimbursement is \$200. Reimbursements will be issued after the trip is completed. Reimbursements will be issued to the trip leader with the checks made out to the club, to be distributed per club policy.

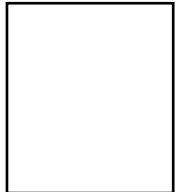

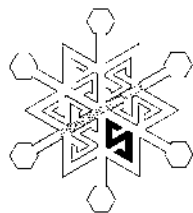
