

There is an Early Bird Special for the first 90 persons to sign up - \$980. This rate is for either 2 or 3 bedroom condos at The Lodge at Steamboat. After those are taken, the rate goes up to \$1016 – this rate goes for either 2 or 3 bedrooms. Add \$343 for a private bedroom.
