

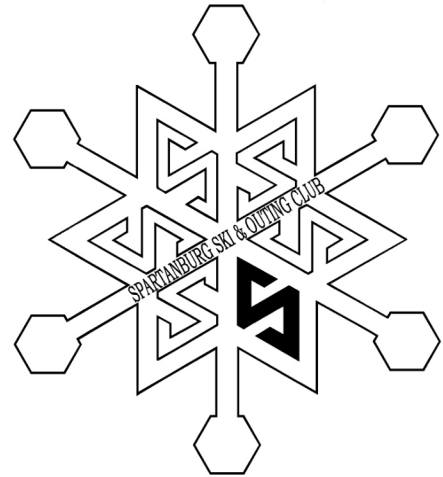

### **CSC Racing**

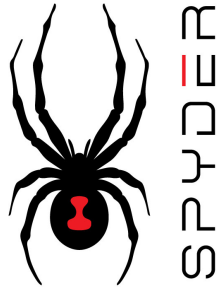
