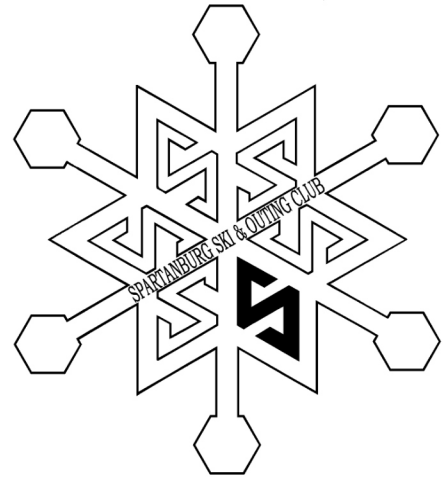

Maggie very much likes live music and the beach so I guess if there were live music at the beach, she'd be a happy camper.

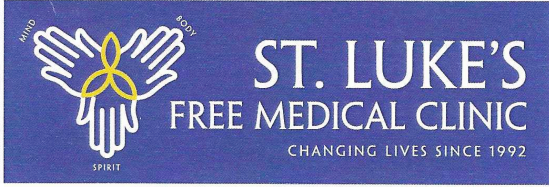

On behalf of all of us at St. Luke's Free Medical Clinic, thank you for your gift of \$260.00 on June 3, 2025. Your generosity isn't just appreciated—it's making a real, lasting difference. Because of your support, we're able to deliver high-quality, compassionate care to neighbors who would otherwise go without. In Spartanburg County, more than 39,000 people live without health insurance—and at least 14,000 of them are facing significant financial hardship.
